Pre-Draft Public Consultation

Notice is hereby given pursuant to Section 20(1) of the Planning and Development Act 2000 (as amended) that Roscommon County Council intends to commence its review of the existing **Boyle Local Area Plan 2015 – 2021** and to prepare a new Local Area Plan for the period 2023 – 2029. The Local Area Plan will be prepared to be consistent with the strategic aims and policy objectives of the recently adopted **Roscommon County Development Plan 2022-2028**.

Issues Paper

In order to stimulate debate and encourage participation in this process an Issues Paper has been prepared and submissions and observations are invited on the topics raised. Informed by this pre-draft consultation, a Draft Boyle Local Area Plan will then be prepared and a statutory public consultation on that Draft Plan will take place later in 2022. The Draft Plan will be informed by and accompanied by a suite of Environmental Reports.

Children or groups or associations representing the interests of children are entitled to make submissions or observations to inform the preparation of the Local Area Plan and to ensure that it will deliver an overall strategy for the proper planning and sustainable development of Boyle.

Requests or proposals for the zoning of particular land for any purpose are premature in this pre-draft consultation phase and will not be considered.

Submissions or observations may be made to the Planning Authority between the 30th June 2022 to 29th July 2022 (both dates inclusive) either:

- (a) In writing to Planning Department, Roscommon County Council, Áras an Chontae, Roscommon, F42 VR98 (Correspondence to be marked 'Boyle Local Area Plan')

or

- (b) In electronic format using the submission function on the website (www.rosdevplan.ie)

Please note, submissions that are e-mailed **cannot** be considered and will be returned. Please make your submission / observation by one medium only i.e. in hard copy or via the website.

The deadline for receipt of all submissions is 4.30pm on the 29th July 2022. Late submissions will not be accepted.

Data Protection

Written observations or submissions received by Roscommon County Council during the pre-draft consultation period will be published on the aforementioned website.

All submissions should include your name and a contact address, and where relevant, details of any organisation, community group or company etc., which you represent.
